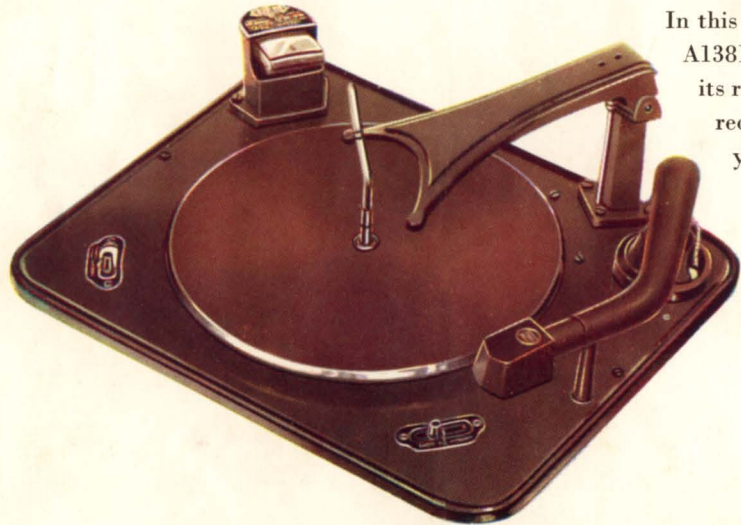

A new Murphy Radiogram should mean and does mean that we have found a way to make a better instrument or a cheaper instrument or—if lucky!—both. This A138R is a better instrument than anything we know of at such a price and that's why it was "born". What do we mean—a "better" instrument?



Needle scratch is a most irritating feature of gramophone reproduction and a most difficult one to eliminate. Needle scratch noises are accentuated by resonance in the gramophone pick-up. In this new Murphy 'Gram—the A138R—the pick-up is so designed that its resonance is *above* all normal recording frequencies. We think you will find the effect quite

astonishing. Not only is there very little needle scratch but the gramophone performance is much fuller and more natural than you are accustomed to. Listening, for instance, to an orchestra on the A138R your ear finds it quite easy to separate the individual instruments. If you're a gramophone enthusiast and are *not* intending to buy a new instrument, you'll be well advised to keep away from the A138R. It is liable to make you dissatisfied with what you now have. Don't say we didn't warn you.
