

CIRCUIT

The circuit of the U144 follows standard superhet practice and uses five valves (including the rectifier). The medium and long wave bands are covered, so providing good reception of all three B.B.C. programmes.

LOUDSPEAKER

A 6½-inch loudspeaker of entirely new design is fitted. This loudspeaker is unusually large for a receiver of this size and sets an entirely new standard of reproduction for such a compact receiver.

CONTROLS

The three controls provided are: Volume and On/Off switch; Wave-change switch; Tuning.

AERIAL

An extremely efficient built-in frame aerial ensures noise-free reception of local stations. A coupling coil is provided so that a normal aerial and earth may be used in areas where no local station exists or when reception of distant stations is required.

CABINET

The dimensions of the moulded cabinet are:

In short, we've made it as convenient as possible for you to get all the fun you want from radio.

Even if you have a perfectly satisfactory set there is still a jolly good case for the U144 in your home. What about the time when somebody wants to hear the play and some one else wants Twenty Questions? Or when some one has to stay in bed? Yes, there's always plenty of use for this fine little set.
